How do I know what's normal?

Have a look at our quick reference charts below

Healthy bowel

Daily soft brown stool, a number four on the Bristol stool chart

Smooth and shaped like a sausage

No straining required

No pain on passing a stool

No bleeding

No leakage or incontinence of stools

Bristol Stool Chart!

Type 1: Separate hard lumps, like nuts (hard to pass)

Type 2: Sausage shaped but lumpy

Type 3: Like a sausage but with cracks on the surface

Type 4: Like a sausage or snake smooth and soft

Type 5: Soft blobs with clear-cut edges

Type 6: Fluffy pieces with ragged edges, a mushy stool

Type 7: Watery, no solid pieces. Entirely liquid

Unhealthy bowel

Passing a stool 3 times a week or less

Hard stools that are difficult to pass

Having to strain to pass a stool

Feeling of incomplete emptying of the bowel

Passing blood from the bowel

Pain on passing a stool

No control over passing a stool - incontinence

Very loose or watery stools

Change from your usual bowel habit
